

## The Kiang Ai Kim Graduate Scholarship

### Introduction

The Kiang Ai Kim Scholarship Fund is established since year 2000 to honour Professor Kiang's contributions to the Department of Chemistry, National University of Singapore (NUS) as well as to the progress of Chemistry in Singapore and the region.

In line with Professor Kiang's affection and scholarship in Chemistry, the **Kiang Ai Kim Graduate Scholarship** is established to encourage qualified students to pursue full-time graduate studies in the NUS Department of Chemistry.

Applicants must be NUS Chemistry B.Sc. (Honours) degree holders with academic excellence, regardless of nationality. He/she must first fulfill the admission requirements to pursue a higher degree by research in the Department.

### The Scholarship

- The Kiang Ai Kim Graduate Scholarship will provide the following:
  - a) Tuition fee support of up to **\$12,000 per year\***,
  - b) A monthly stipend of **\$3800** throughout the period of award<sup>#</sup>, and
  - c) Up to S\$4,000 conference support, claimable in either Year 3 or 4.
- The Scholarship is tenable for 1 year in the first instance and renewable each semester subject to the Scholar's satisfactory progress. The maximum period of award is 4 years
- The Scholarship cannot be held in conjunction with other scholarships or industrial sponsorship.
- The Scholars are free to choose any area of research under the supervision of a faculty member in Chemistry Department.
- The Scholars are required to assist the Department in teaching or other duties, similarly as applied to its other graduate students receiving MOE graduate scholarships.
- The Scholars should maintain strong commitment and integrity to Science and research, following Professor Kiang as role model.

### How to apply

- Interested applicants should submit a one-page personal statement to the Department, introducing his/her background, motivation, commitment, etc.
- Short-listed candidates may be called for an interview when necessary.

Subject to the Fund's availability, the call for application may not be open each year. The upcoming call for application is for AY2025 intake, and the deadline is 15 Nov 2024.
